



PROPERTY OWNERS MAY BE ELIGIBLE FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF!

- \$ If you are a homeowner who will be 66 years of age before January 1, 2010 **and** you had 2008 household income of less than \$28,732 you **may** be eligible for the "Circuit Breaker" tax abatement ("reduction").
- \$ If you are a service connected disabled veteran you are eligible for an exemption of up to \$228,505 of the taxable value of your real or personal property, including motor vehicles.
- \$ If you are blind and own real or personal property, you are eligible for an exemption of up to \$11,500 of the taxable value of your real or personal property, including motor vehicles.
- \$ If you are a homeowner who will be 65 years of age before January 1, 2010 **and** you had 2008 household income of less than \$28,732, **and** you are unable to pay the property tax when due, you may be eligible for an indigent tax abatement ("reduction").
- \$ If you are a homeowner of any age **and** you are unable to pay the property tax when due as a result of hardship or disability, you may be eligible for a hardship abatement ("reduction").

FILE TAX RELIEF APPLICATIONS WITH THE COUNTY TREASURER BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2009.

Applicants must meet eligibility requirements before tax relief can be granted. If you believe you may qualify for tax relief, contact the Salt Lake County Treasurer's Office at 801-468-3400 and select Option 1 to speak to a Tax Relief Specialist.

PLEASE DO NOT PAY THE ESTIMATED TAXES SHOWN IN THIS VALUATION NOTICE!

TAXES ARE BILLED ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 1, AND ARE DELINQUENT AFTER NOVEMBER 30, 2009. The TAX NOTICE mailed in October shows the actual amount of taxes due for 2009 and may also include GARBAGE COLLECTION FEES and ATTACHMENTS such as delinquent municipal services billings and credits for tax prepayments and for approved TAX RELIEF.
